

# RGVSCA Split Meet- Weslaco

## October 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019

### LOCATION

The pool is located at 801 East 7<sup>th</sup> street in Weslaco. Get off the expressway at Texas fm 88 and turn south. Go until you get to 6<sup>th</sup> street, turn left and go by Central Middle School. Turn right on Bridge Street, go to 7<sup>th</sup> street and turn right. You will see the pool from Bridge Street.

### ATHLETE AND SPECTATOR SEATING

Due to the space limitation of our facility, all swim teams will be required to set up camp outside of the facility. All teams are highly encouraged to bring canopies. By order of the City of Weslaco fire marshal, folding chairs will not be permitted inside the facility. Additionally, spectator ticket sales will be limited to 280. Please let parents know that there will be a limit to the number of tickets sold in order to comply with our facility's fire code.

### COURSE

The Weslaco pool is an indoor facility with 8 lanes and 2 maxi-flex model "B" diving boards. Full automatic timing with Daktronics touch pads will be in place for the meet. A Daktronics score board with lane assignments and splits will be used for the meet.

### EVENTS

Diving will be on Friday, October 11<sup>th</sup>. Warm-up at 11:00a.m., start at 12:00p.m. We will follow a 6 dive format. Swimming warm-ups will begin at 7:30 a.m. and each warm-up session will 25 minutes long. Scratches are due by 9:00. Meet will start after all scratches are in and heat sheets are printed.

### READY BENCH

The bleachers located on the south end of the building, closest to the starting block, will be the designated ready bench. All swimmers waiting for their event to be called up must wait in that area and not in the area directly located behind the starting blocks.

### SCORING

Team scoring will be to 16 places.

### AWARDS

Top three places will receive medals, fourth through eighth place will receive ribbons.

### ENTRIES

Each school can make an unlimited number of entries in individual events. Relays are limited to two entries. Entries and dive sheets are due no later than Wednesday, October 9<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 p.m. No paper entries will be accepted. 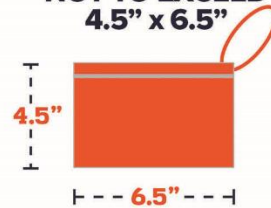

 RE-SEALABLE  
 CLEAR PLASTIC

**SMALL CLUTCH w/STRAP  
 NOT TO EXCEED  
 4.5" x 6.5"**



### LARGE BAGS

- Must be: Clear Plastic, Vinyl, or PVC
- Must not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"

No more than one logo, not obstructing contents

### SMALL BAGS

- Clutch bag (with/without strap)
- Does not need to be clear
- Must not exceed 4.5" x 6.5"

### PROHIBITED BAGS

1. Purses larger than a clutch



2. Printed or patterned plastic or vinyl bags



3. Backpacks (solid or clear)



4. Computer bags



5. Camera bags



6. Oversized tote bags



7. Diaper bags (place diaper bag items in clear bag to gain entry)



8. Mesh or straw bags



9. Briefcases or fanny packs



10. Luggage or duffel bags of any kind



\*Exceptions will be made for medically necessary items and diaper bags after proper inspection at designated areas.
